

## Wanni troops recover LTTE gas bombs during search



Troops in the Wanni, during a search operation have recovered LTTE gas bombs together with a large cache of explosives and communication equipment, the Army website reported. According to the military 10 CF gas bombs were recovered during the search and clear operation.

Troops conducting the search and clear operation at Elephant pass, Mullaittivu, Puthukkudiruppu, Nadunkerni and Vellaimullivakkal on Saturday also recovered two 120 mm mortar bombs, three Rocket Propelled Grenades (RPG), six 60 mm mortar bombs, one Arul bomb, three trip player, four Yesu sets, five I-com radio sets, fourteen I-com hand sets, four wire codes, twenty supper rod antennas, forty-eight Yesu antennas, four battery chargers, thirty-five antenna sockets, one computer hard disk, sixty-eight two-pin connectors, forty-seven wire socket connectors, fifty-seven VHF sockets, one DVB power supply, eighteen I-com clips, forty-four VHF sockets, five data cables, ten antenna power supplies, six hundred and eight spare parts of radio sets, three hundred and thirty anti personnel mines, three Bangalore torpedoes, eight T-56 weapons, three T-56 magazines, forty-nine hand grenades, one claymore mine, one suicide jacket, nine hundred and sixty-eight electric detonators, 50.3 kg of C-4 explosives, eleven 40 mm Grenade Launchers and two pipes filled with ball bearings.
