### **Troops uncover artillery pieces in Mullaittivu**

Security forces engaged in clearing operations along the Eastern coast of Puthukkudiyirippu, Mullaittivu have uncovered 05 artillery guns yesterday Nov 08).

According to finalized military reports received, finding included 04x 152mm artillery guns and a 130mm artillery gun. The artillery pieces were buried in the beach, the sources further said.
